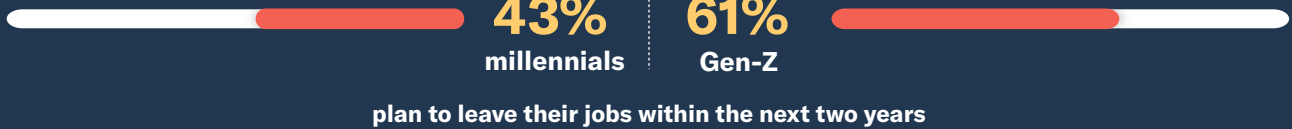

31% higher productivity
37% higher sales

2X average revenue
